# Kegler's Pro Shop 2017-2018 Tournaments

1. Tournaments are open to all adult bowlers. All amateur and PBA bowlers are eligible to bowl. Bowlers can begin to check in one hour before start time. All walk-in entries will be accepted as long as space MAX limit has not been reached.
2. **AVERAGES:** Entrants will use their highest USBC sanctioned league average based on a minimum of 21 games for the 2016-2017 season. Summer leagues **included**. If average, as of date of bowling (21 games or more), is 10 pins higher than the 2016-2017 season's average, the higher average must be used. The bowler's highest reported average, including re-rates, will be used. If no average last year, use highest sanctioned average of 21 games or more, with league secretary's verification or current league standing sheet. **ALL OTHERS BOWL SCRATCH.**
3. **HANDICAP RULES:** Entrants must have bowled 21 or more games in a sanctioned league to be eligible for the handicap of 80% of 220 in Singles, 80% of 440 in Doubles. Any entrant not eligible for a handicap must enter at 220.
4. **FORMAT:** Qualifying consists of 5 games. Finals will be stepladder format #5 vs #4, winner vs #3, winner vs #2, winner vs #1 in one-game matches with the exception of the of No Tap (5 games, total pin fall) and the Open (Top 6 NFL Style finals)
5. **PAYOUT:** Payout will be a 1:5 payout ratio. Entry Fee Breakdown: Prize fund: \$20.00 Expenses: \$15.00  
**Estimated Payout for Singles events** (Based on 25 entries)  
1<sup>st</sup> Place \$300.00 – 2<sup>nd</sup> Place \$200.00 – 3<sup>rd</sup> Place \$100.00 – 4<sup>th</sup> Place \$75.00 – 5<sup>th</sup> Place \$50.00
6. Proper attire and behavior is requested. Tournament management has the right to disqualify any bowler for not following proper conduct. No refunds will be issued. Bowlers are only permitted to change the surface of a bowling ball during practice. After competition begins, no changing the surface of any bowling ball is permitted. One-lane courtesy during competition will be requested.
7. All tournaments are non-sanctioned. Tournament director has final say on any rule changes not covered here specifically. This is to ensure fairness in competition.
